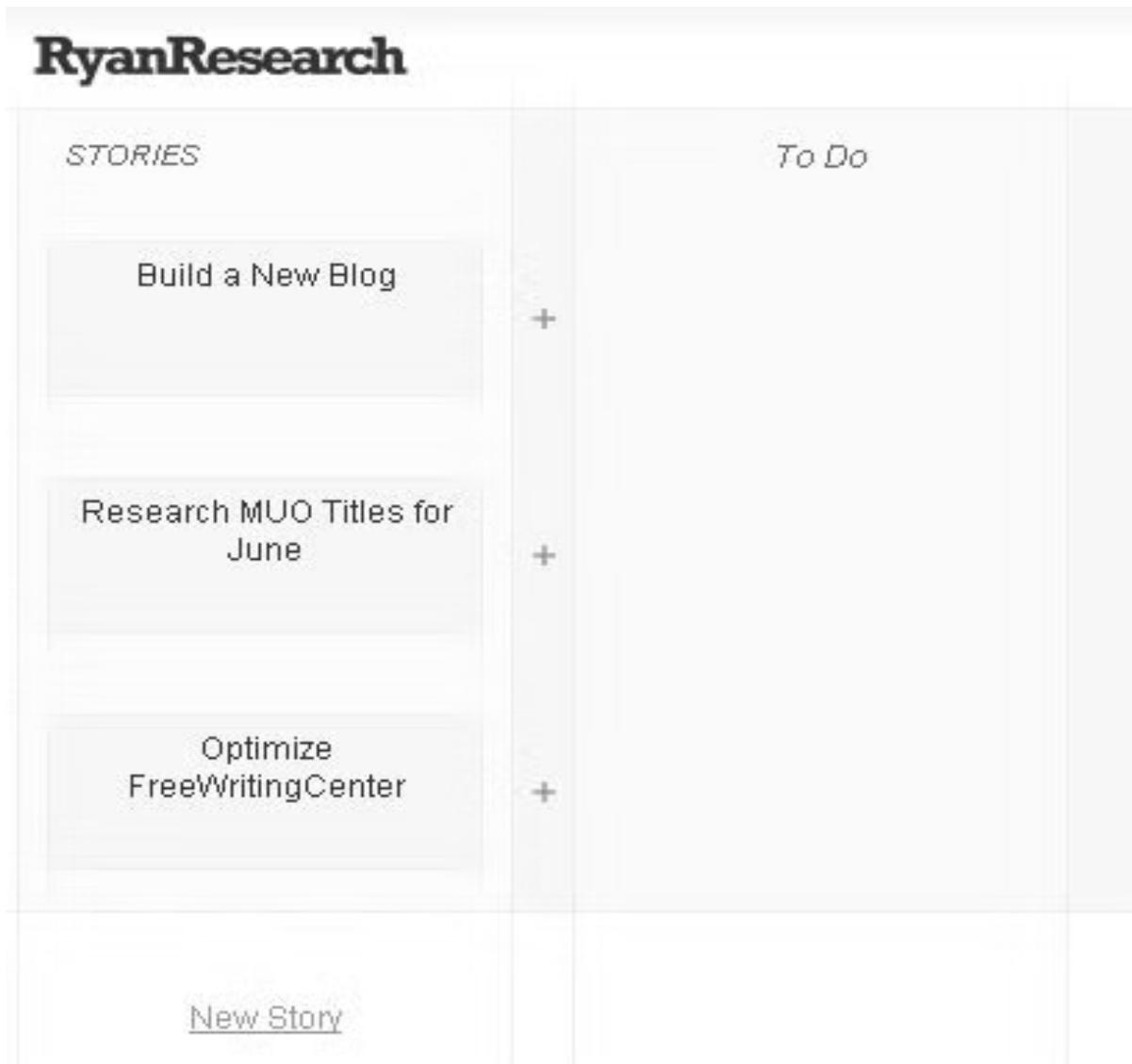


## Summary: Visual Collaboration with Scrummy

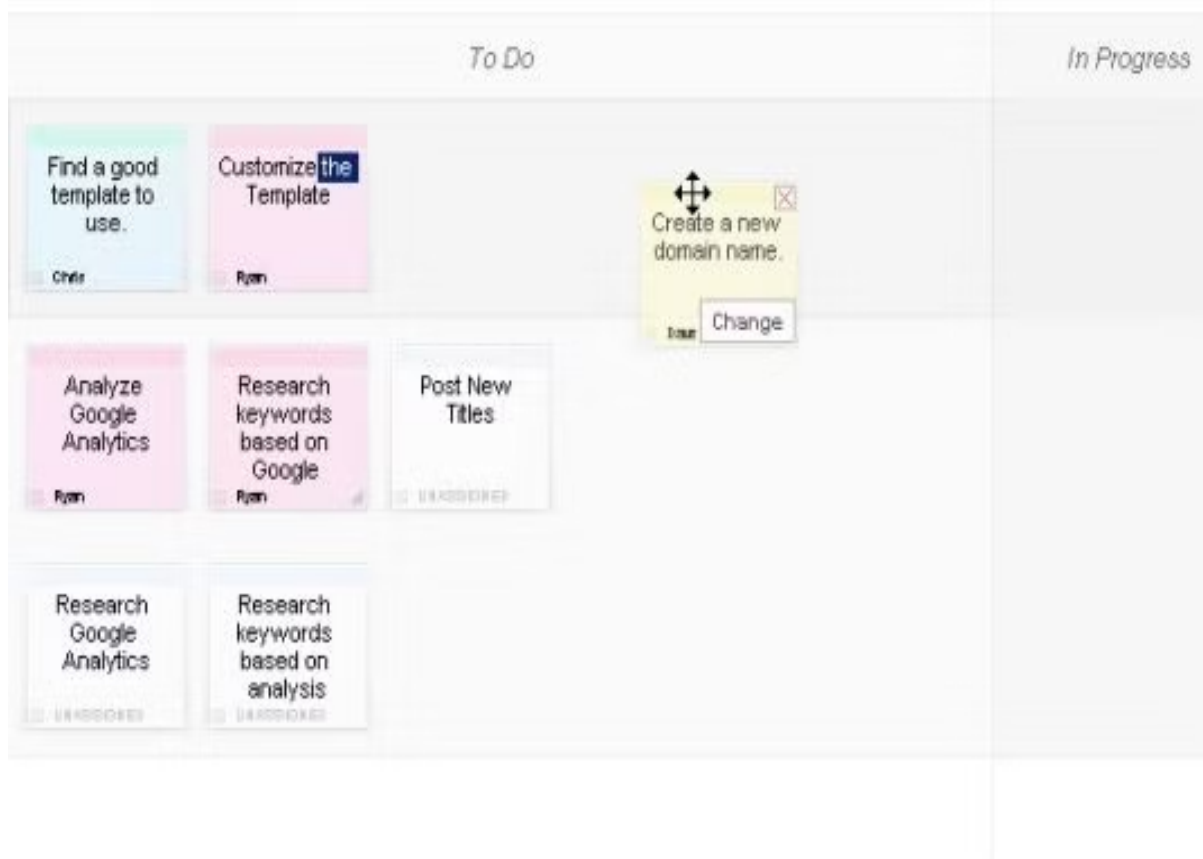
